# BRICKLAYERS & ALLIED CRAFTWORKERS INSURANCE BENEFIT TRUST FUND OF ALBERTA AND SASKATCHEWAN



We are presenting our Annual Report, which outlines the activities of the Fund during the year ended July 31, 2021.

Throughout the year under review, benefits of approximately \$920,168 were paid to eligible Bricklayers and their dependents.

As illustrated in the accompanying pages, the Fund's Expenses (when combined with the decrease in the Hour Bank liability) exceeded Income by \$4,400. This decreased the Fund Equity at July 31, 2021 to \$2,320,270. An audit has been performed on the records of the Fund and Financial Statements are available for examination at the Fund Office.

### **Benefit Plan Improvements**

During 2021, the Board of Trustees announced the following benefit enhancements for claims incurred on and after the respective effective dates:

### **Health Spending Account**

Effective January 1, 2021, an additional contribution amount was added in the amount of \$500 per member.

### **Dental Benefit**

Effective January 1, 2021, the Dental Fee Guide is being upgraded to the 2020 Fee Guide.

### Weekly Disability Benefit

Effective July 1, 2021, the Weekly Disability benefit increased from \$573 to \$595 per week.

### **New Benefit Plan Improvements**

As of January 1, 2022, the Board of Trustees are pleased to announce the following benefit enhancements for claims incurred on and after the respective effective date:

#### **Extended Health Care**

The **practitioner maximum** is being changed from a \$300 combined calendar year maximum to a **\$300 per practitioner maximum** per calendar year, per person for the services of a chiropractor, physiotherapist and massage therapist, including x-ray charges. Laboratory tests and x-rays performed by a chiropractor up to a maximum of \$25 per calendar year.

### **Vision Care Benefit**

■ The vision care maximum is being amended from \$400 to \$600 for eyeglass frames and lenses or contact lenses during any 24 consecutive month period from the last date of service (12 month period from the last date of service for persons under 18 years of age); coverage also includes reimbursement of safety glasses for Members.

#### **Dental Benefit**

- The basic services maximum is being increased from \$1,500 to \$2,000 per calendar year, per person.
- The major services maximum is being increased from \$1,500 to \$2,000 per calendar year, per person.

If you have coverage through another Plan it is possible that any expenses you may have that are not reimbursed under the Fund may be reimbursed under your other coverage. We encourage you to submit any amounts that are not reimbursed by the Fund to your other coverage. Furthermore, any amounts that are not reimbursed may be eligible for reimbursement from a Member's Health Spending Account (HSA).




